Additional Campus Facilities include Air-Conditioned Cafeteria, Recital Hall, Classrooms, OWTV Studio, Computer Labs, and more!

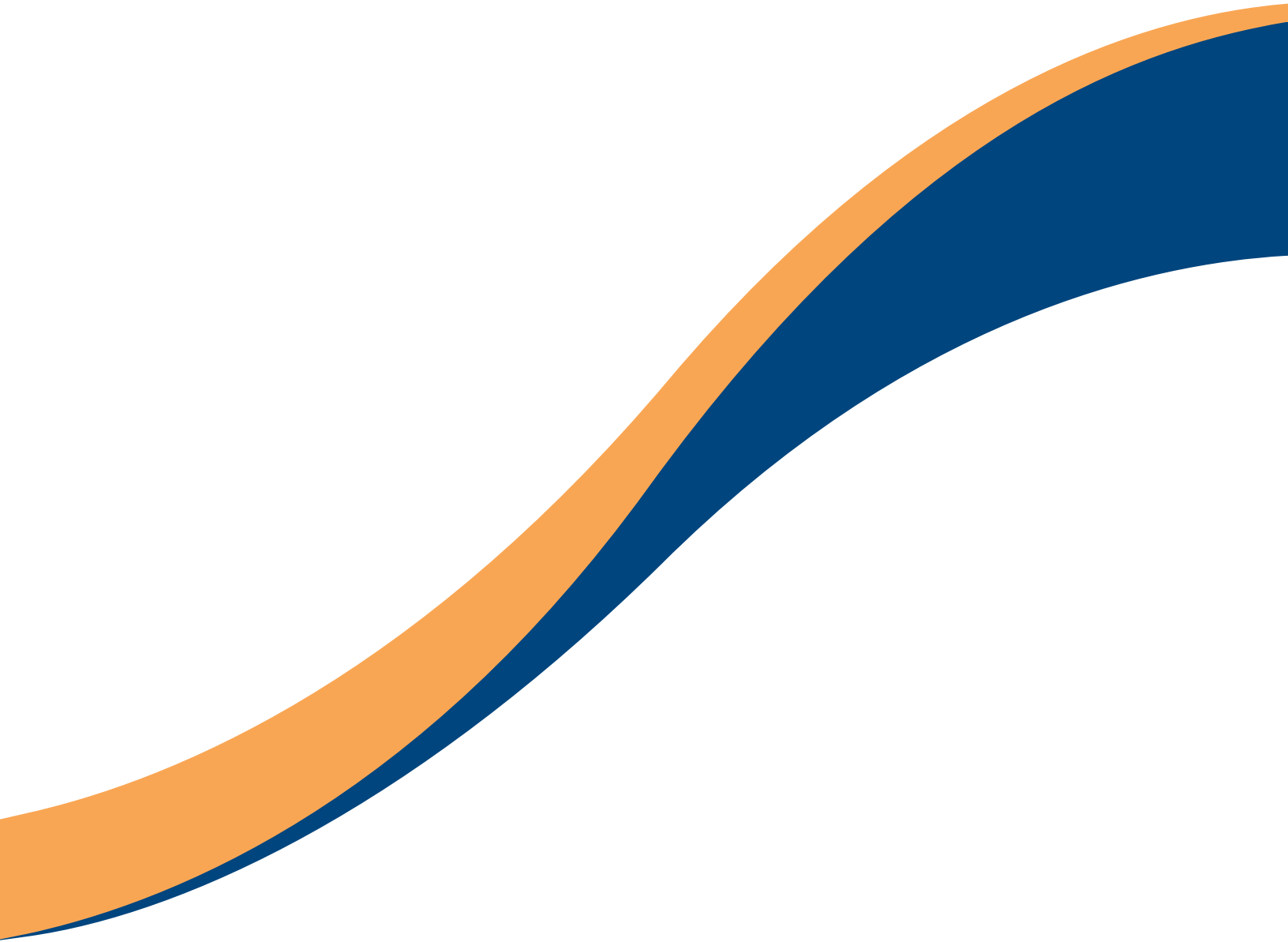
